



Par Car Track Enclosure Installation Instructions

Par Car:

The Par Car track enclosure is installed by mounting the aluminum rails directly under the roof to the black posts on the car. The aluminum rails are attached to the golf car with the notch at the rear of the car even with the black posts and the **c-channel facing downward and outward and the flat side facing upward and inward**. The rails are installed by using pop rivets. If you do not have a pop rivet gun, screws can also be used.

After the rails are installed, just slide the beaded portions of the enclosure through the c-channels.

Club Protectors and Full Backs:

For the club protector or full back and straight back, mount the rails on the rear top supports or black posts. Normally, the club protector or full back rail is mounted on the outside of the posts with the **c-channel facing downward and outward**. The straight back rail is mounted on the inside of the posts with the **c-channel facing downward and inward**.

After the rails are installed, just slide the beaded portions of the enclosure through the c-channels.

At this point your track style is installed. Please keep in mind that there is not one specific way to install the enclosure, so please feel free to mount the enclosure where you feel it best fits and works for the customer.
